



# Excalibur Hotel & Casino Commits to lotus Pro Chemical-free Cleaning

LAS VEGAS—After a successful trial beginning in September 2008, MGM's Excalibur Hotel and Casino is now using lotus PRO chemical-free cleaning in its 4,000-room facility. Made on the spot and on demand, lotus PRO's liquefied ozone is 50 percent stronger and faster than bleach, yet reverts to water and oxygen once heavy-duty cleaning is done.

Following a successful rollout starting in September 2008, the Las Vegas landmark's guestroom attendants and janitorial staff are now all using the lotus PRO Commercial Cleaning & Sanitizing System—cleaning effectively with liquefied ozone instead of packaged green or conventional chemical cleaners.

The lotus PRO technology uses standard 110-volt power to turn tap water into liquefied ozone—widely acknowledged as nature's most powerful cleaner and sanitizer. Faster and 50 percent stronger than chlorine bleach, it reverts to water and oxygen after its job is done, leaving no residues or vapors. It kills up to 99.999 percent of most common bacteria, viruses, molds and fungi, yet is safe enough to carry a 0-0-0-A NFPA rating and a perfect 50 out of 50 TURI safety score. Because liquefied ozone is made on the spot, it not only saves the planet from pollutants associated with chemical sanitizers, it also eliminates the carbon footprint from packaging, transporting, storing and recycling associated with green cleaners.

## Trade Show Sparked Interest

From the moment Excalibur management saw a lotus PRO demonstration at an ISSA trade show, they were taken by the idea of heavy-duty cleaning without chemicals. With an inkling that lotus PRO was the way to go, Excalibur gave it a green light to begin on-site testing.

Working closely with the lotus PRO technical and support teams, Excalibur completed the transition away from chemical sanitizers and green cleaners over a six-month period. Excalibur successfully replaced various chemicals they were using for different surfaces and applications, cutting cleaning costs on a per room basis by approximately 40 percent.

“At first the people at Excalibur were skeptical because there was no scent, no foam and no bubbles,” says lotus PRO inventor and company president Steve Hengsperger. “Turning tap water into an all-in-one industrial strength cleaner is hard to wrap your head around if you're used to scented chemicals. Now they have people asking us where they can buy lotus cleaning systems for their personal use at home.”
